

Sample Material/s Request Agreement

A Sample Material/s Request Agreement (SMA) is a contract between a provider and a recipient for the transfer of sample research materials and data.

An SMA defines the terms and conditions under which a provider is willing to transfer materials to a recipient and substantially reduces the possibility of future misunderstandings between the provider and recipient of materials.

While SMAs with academic or non-profit institutions are generally negotiated and approved rapidly, SMAs for materials provided to for-profit companies require more time to negotiate and approve, since many companies propose terms and conditions which may conflict with the Associations approved policies and guidelines.

The most common issues that require negotiation are publication rights, the future availability of the materials, and intellectual property provisions.
